



This Code of Conduct outlines appropriate behaviours expected from all members of Tattenhall Runners.

It is our intention to maintain a safe and secure environment for everyone in order to contribute to a friendly and enjoyable atmosphere within the club. As a responsible runner you are expected to respect the rights, dignity and worth of every runner, coach and person involved in athletics and to treat everyone equally. This includes both face-to-face and in digital communications such as email and social media.

Some examples of expected behaviours are:

- Cooperate fully with others involved in the sport such as coaches, run leaders and marshals/helpers at events.
- Anticipate and be responsible for your own needs, including: being organised, wearing appropriate clothing and equipment (e.g. high-vis when needed), and being on time.
- Always thank the run-leaders and other volunteers who enable you to participate in club activities.

All new members of the club will be asked to sign up to this code of conduct.
